College football season is just around the corner and the fall season will be here before you know it. But before we all settle into the bleachers, there's one thing to take care of first.

All agency heads and political subdivisions must prepare and submit the small and minority business set-aside program goal reports which are due to DAS on or before August 30, 2008.

So the first quarter is over at the end of September (reports due October 30). Second quarter is over the end of December (reports due January 30). Third quarter is over the end of March (reports due April 30) and the Fourth quarter is over the end June (reports due July 30).

BuyLines will run quarterly reminders of important filing dates for agencies and political subdivisions.

Automating Procurement Processes Puts States at the Head of the Class

In a recent report card grading the quality of government programs in the states, only three states received A's.

Not coincidentally, all three states are investors in e-procurement systems. The PEW Center on the States recently graded the states based on the quality of their programs in four areas: money, people, infrastructure and information.

Only 13 states scored better than a B minus, and only three states scored the highest grade: an A minus. The three top states were Virginia, Utah and Washington. (GovPro.com)
