Reminder from DAS Commissioner

Due to the ongoing fiscal difficulties facing our state, this memo serves to remind all Agency Heads that the spending directives previously issued by both Governor Rell and DAS remains in full force and effect.

I am specifically reminding you that agencies have been directed to freeze all purchasing except for those goods and services that are absolutely and immediately essential to the agencies' operations. This prohibition applies regardless of whether the source of funding is the General Fund, a revolving fund, a non-appropriated or other appropriated fund, or bond funds (including the Capital Equipment Purchase Fund).

Agencies have recently asked about the application of these rules to the purchase of vehicles and information technology products and services. They do apply. Please note:

- As stated above, any such purchase must be absolutely and immediately essential to the agencies' operations.
- Pursuant to Executive Order #22, only DAS and DOT have the authority to purchase passenger cars and light-duty trucks. Agencies may not purchase such vehicles themselves.
- The Chief Information Officer of DOIT must approve all agency purchases of information technology products or services.

As always, I thank you for your cooperation in these difficult fiscal times.

DAS Procurement recently awarded an All Using State Agency contract ([09PSX0015](#)) for Rubbish Removal and Recycling Services which includes white paper recycling.

Currently agencies have their individual site specific contracts for rubbish removal and recycling services. As these contracts begin to expire, agencies will need to select the vendor(s) that best fit their business needs by utilizing the Master Price Schedule link found in the contract. Each tab within the spreadsheet contains all of the vendor's prices by category types, container sizes and by town. Be sure to select the vendor(s) that best accommodate your specific business needs.

Please note that Bradley International Airport, the Department of Environmental Protection Parks and the Department of Correction Correctional Facilities will not be included in this Contract.
