Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:

This position is responsible for the safety, care, and supervision of children in an assigned cottage. Duties include the effective implementation of the milieu program, social skills groups, coaching of daily living skills, engaging the children in therapeutic activities, oversee and guide daily living activities, money management, dispensing medication and transporting to and from various types of appointments. Children Services Workers are also responsible for writing incident reports and significant events such as runaways as well as treatment progress notes. Performs other related duties as required. General Experience:

Requires two years of paraprofessional experience in an applied treatment program for emotionally disturbed, delinquent, behaviorally disordered, educationally deficient or mentally retarded children or youth.

Substitution Allowed:

An Associate's Degree in the health, human services or mental health areas may be substituted for the General Experience. Thirty college credits in a course of study leading to a Bachelor's Degree in the behavioral sciences may be substituted for one year of the General Experience

Working Conditions:

Incumbents in this class may be required to lift or restrain residents and may have significant exposure to risk of injury from assaulting and/or abusive residents.

Note: The filling of this position shall be in keeping with established reemployment, transfer, promotion, and SEBAC employment obligations.
