This position is open to candidates who possess a Bachelor's Degree in Civil Engineering. State employees currently holding the above title may apply for lateral transfer. Other qualifications are noted below.

**Description of Duties:** Incumbent will receive training in introductory professional engineering work for the development of technical and professional engineering skills and knowledge in order to qualify for advancement to a Civil Engineer 1 position. Performs a wide range of increasingly difficult duties as technical skills are acquired, including but not limited to, performing tasks involving engineering studies and inspections of roads, bridges, water and sewer systems, buildings and other related infrastructure. Assists with structural engineering calculations, hydraulic flow computations, cost estimating, topographic surveying and other related tasks.

**Preferred Criteria:**

- General knowledge of basic civil engineering theories, principles and methods
- Skill in use of computer aided design software (AutoCAD) and other computer applications
- The ability to prioritize and track multiple tasks
- Interpersonal skills
- Oral and written communication skills
- Ability to analyze, interpret and evaluate civil engineering issues
- Ability to prepare technical reports

**Special Experience:**

- Appointment to this class shall be for a period of not more than two (2) years or until the promulgation of an eligible list from the first examination announced by the State Personnel Division one (1) year after date of appointment for a class for which incumbent qualifies from on-the-job training
