PURPOSE OF CLASS: In the Department of Transportation this class is accountable for acting as a working supervisor for an assigned group of Department of Transportation Maintainers and/or Qualified Craft Workers engaged in field maintenance and repair of traffic signals, illumination and related electrical and electronic equipment.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS REQUIRED

THIS PROMOTIONAL EXAMINATION IS OPEN TO ANY **CURRENT** EMPLOYEE OF THE **DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION** WHO BY **MAY 23, 2013** HAS PERMANENT STATUS IN THE CLASSIFIED SERVICES,* SIX MONTHS CURRENT OR FORMER SERVICE IN THE **DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION**, AND THE FOLLOWING EXPERIENCE AND TRAINING:

GENERAL EXPERIENCE: One year of skilled experience in field maintenance and repair of traffic signals, illumination and related electrical and electronic equipment. [Note: For state employees the General Experience will be interpreted at the level of Department of Transportation Maintainer 3.]

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS: (1) Incumbents in this class will be required to accept assignment to emergency duties including snow and ice removal as required. (2) Incumbents in this class may be required by the appointing authority to possess the appropriate current licenses or permits.

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENT: Incumbents in this class must have adequate physical strength, stamina and agility and visual and auditory acuity and must maintain such physical fitness necessary for effective performance of the duties. A physical examination may be required.

WORKING CONDITIONS: (1) Incumbents in this class are exposed to extremes of weather conditions, to frequent lifting of heavy weights, to highly dangerous road and traffic conditions, including exposure to heights when working on bridges, to poison ivy, insect bites and allergy irritants during summer months, and to loud and potentially dangerous machinery. (2) The appointing authority may require completion of an asbestos removal program consistent with EPA guidelines for operations and maintenance during employment in this class. Incumbents may be required to use protective equipment such as respirators and safety goggles.

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES (KSA's): Knowledge of the materials, equipment and approved methods in the maintenance and repair of electrical and electronic equipment; ability to perform electrical and electronic tests in locating defects; ability to install, maintain, and repair electrical and electronic equipment; Interpersonal skills; oral and written communication skills; some supervisory ability.

Make certain your application form clearly details your employment history, including job titles, dates of employment and actual job duties as well as college degrees earned and current licenses and certifications. **Mail applications to DAS/Human Resources, Room 404, State Office Building, 165 Capitol Avenue, Hartford, Connecticut 06106-1658 (Secure Fax #860-622-2910).** If faxing materials, keep a copy of your completed application form and the fax transmittal receipt for your records. Make certain that your application form is complete and transmitted correctly and without error. Incomplete faxes or faxes received blank because pages were faxed upside down will not be accepted. Due to the large number of applications received, we cannot confirm receipt of applications. **Applications must be date stamped by DAS/Human Resources or postmarked by May 23, 2013. A separate application form must be submitted for each exam you are applying for.**
