**Eligibility Requirement:** Candidates must have applied for and passed the Transportation Public Concessions Inspector examination and be on the current certification list promulgated by the Department of Administrative Services for this classification. State employees currently holding the above title or those who have previously attained permanent status may apply for lateral transfer.

**Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:** Knowledge of the principles and practices of food service and vending facility operations; knowledge of food sanitation and personal hygiene practices as related to food production; knowledge of and ability to interpret and apply relevant state and federal laws and regulations; interpersonal skills; oral and written communication skills; ability to utilize computer software.

**General Experience:** Five (5) years of experience in the management of a food service facility. Management is defined as being the owner, manager or assistant manager of a restaurant, food service operation, minimart or other area where food is served.

**Substitutions Allowed:**

1. College training in hotel and restaurant management, food service management, business administration or a closely related field may be substituted for the General Experience on the basis of fifteen (15) semester hours equaling one-half (1/2) year of experience to a maximum of four (4) years.
2. Two (2) years of experience in the inspection of food service operations may be substituted for the General Experience

**Special Requirements:**

1. Incumbents in this class are required to work a rotating shift which includes nights, holidays and weekends.
2. Incumbents in this class will be required to travel.
3. Incumbents in this class may be required to possess and retain a valid Motor Vehicle Operator's license

**Note:** The filling of this position will be in accordance with reemployment, SEBAC, transfer, promotion and merit employment rules, if applicable.

Applicants who do not submit all the requested documents will not be considered.
