The 110 Sherman Street Property constructed in the early 1800's, and was part of the Hartford Seminary. It is a five story structure with Gothic architectural styling. The property is approximately 32,170 sq. ft. on 19.66 acres.

The building along with four others was sold to the State of Connecticut approximately twenty years ago. It was rehabilitated in 1985 to suit the needs of its present users. The building now is solely occupied by the Office of the Attorney General.
