DAS Procurement enters into NEW Nationwide contract with Enterprise Rent-a-Car and National Car Rental

Starting May 1, 2014 the way you rent a car as a Connecticut state employee will not change, however, the contract number will.

DAS Procurement has entered into an agreement with the WSCA-NASPO Cooperative Purchasing Organization resulting in rental cost savings and added conveniences for employees.

As a state of Connecticut employee using the contract, you are eligible for Emerald Club program benefits. All National and Enterprise locations in North America recognize Emerald Club participation and should have added value to the rental process for employees.

WSCA-NASPO represents a unified, nationally-focused cooperative purchasing program that will leverage the collective expertise and experience of WSCA-NASPO, aggregate the demand of all 50 states, the District of Columbia and the five organized territories, and their political subdivisions and other eligible entities, and help spur innovation and competition in the marketplace

The new contract number is **13PSX0302** and takes effect May 1. The contract is set to expire in October 2015, however, DAS Procurement is planning on taking advantage of a 5 year extension.
