## Classified and Legal Notice Advertising Contract now available

All client agencies will be pleased to know that beginning June 1, 2012 a new contract award went into effect for Classified Advertising and Legal Notices - 12PSX0051.

The awarded vendor is Graystone Group Advertising. The new contract lists all the rates and discounted rates for the major newspapers of Connecticut. In addition, there are guidelines in the contract document to ensure that every client is following the same procedure in placing their ad and legal notices.

Based on the response from several Connecticut state agencies, notarized affidavits are no longer being required. Therefore, once an ad has been placed, the agency will receive from Graystone, a proof from the publication showing the ad, publication name and publication date as well as the invoice. If an affidavit is required for your agency, please be sure to let Graystone know this otherwise they will not provide one. The charge for the affidavit will be \$25 for each ad placed.
