State Announces New Vendor for Public Safety Vehicles

The Department of Administrative Services Procurement Division announced the award of contract **12PSX0194** for public safety vehicles (Ford police Interceptor) to the company MHQ which has a 13,500 square foot facility in Middletown, CT.

MHQ is one of the region’s largest suppliers to police, fire, public works, construction, college/universities and other public service agencies in the Northeast. State agencies are directed to use the contract when purchasing Ford police Interceptor vehicles (Taurus and utility).

“A real positive result of our negotiations is the fact that state agencies will be able to purchase 2014 vehicles at 2013 prices,” said DAS Procurement Director Carol Wilson. “We find this to be extremely competitive not to mention the additional savings to agencies and, in turn, Connecticut taxpayers.”

Bill Kieckhafer, CEO of MHQ said, “MHQ is very pleased to be awarded this important contract for state police vehicles. MHQ has been upfitting public safety vehicles in Connecticut since the early 2000’s and recently relocated to a new facility in Middletown. As a result of our new building, which features over 4-times the space of our previous building and the new state police contract, MHQ is in the process of doubling our work staff to meet our customer’s needs and to ensure delivery of the highest quality upfitted vehicles to the state police and all MHQ’s Connecticut customers. We are also pleased to announce that, for the first time, MHQ will maintain an inventory of law enforcement purpose-built vehicles on site to ensure timely vehicle delivery.”
