What happens when a contract expires? And what should you do?

Contract Award 06ITZ0034 for Cisco Products is due to expire May 21, 2013. DAS/Procurement is in the process of awarding a new contract for Cisco products.

To meet your needs for this product line, you may either utilize your delegated purchase authority under General Letter #71, or call Kris Wohlgemuth if you have other needs.

Please continue to watch the State Contracting Portal and the Buylines newsletter for updates on newly awarded DAS contracts including the replacement DAS contract for Cisco products which we anticipate executing this summer.

Can Contractors use the State of Connecticut to endorse their product?

DAS/Procurement Services would like to remind its contractors and end users that per the terms and conditions of our contracts, contractors should not refer to sales to the State for advertising or promotional purposes:

24. Advertising. The Contractor shall not refer to sales to the State for advertising or promotional purposes, including, but not limited to, posting any material or data on the Internet, without DAS's prior written approval.

If you are approached by a DAS/Procurement Services Contractor for any type of advertising or promotional purpose please refer them to Item #24 of their Contract document and refrain from providing feedback. Electronic Subscriptions

Agency purchasing personnel should be aware that purchases of subscriptions, including electronic subscriptions are allowable as a “non-competitive” purchase under General Letter #71(d).

Agencies do not need to send an ITD-10 requisition through Core-10 for advance approval from BEST for such purchases. Agencies may use their P-Card or issue their purchase order directly with the contractor for such purchases.
