## Due to Customer Demand....

DAS/Procurement Services has entered into an agreement with Home Depot and state agencies can now go to a local Home Depot store to select and carry out purchased items or have the items delivered to their facility.

Contract Award [12PSX0221](#) will run from October 1, 2012 through July 31, 2014 and will be for the purchase of lumber and building supplies. Registration instructions for a user account with Home Depot, and guidelines for using the contract can be found within Contract Award 12PSX0221.

DAS has also issued Contract Award [12PSX0223](#) for the purchase of lumber with The Hartford Lumber Company. This contract will run from October 1, 2012 through September 30, 2014. Customers will be able to have their purchased items delivered to their facility or picked up if more convenient.

DAS' new electronic recycling contract does both.

As technology increases more and more computers and electronic devices come onto the market, but as we all know, when a hot new electronic device comes along, there's an old one to get rid of.

The last electronic recycling contract negotiated charged the state for pickup and disposal of items. This new contract actually offers rebates to state agencies for certain items. Don't worry town and municipalities; you can use this new contract as well.

Reusing and recycling have been the anthem for taking care of our environment. Electronics can now be disassembled with their unique components being reused or repurposed and kept out of our landfills. If your agency, town, municipality or political subdivision has 20 or more items ready for recycling use this form.

To see which items qualify for a rebate read the information here.

Consider the savings to the state of Connecticut. The previous 3-year contract was for \$344,000 plus an estimate of \$170,000 in rebates which equals \$514,000 in savings with this new electronic recycling contract.
