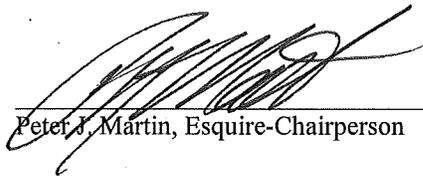
#### 6. Firearm Request/non-capias
