

ITEM 1632E

REVISED EXECUTIVE PAY SCHEDULE

In accordance with Sections 4-40 and 5-208(a) of the Connecticut General Statutes, Item No.1632E provides for establishment of the following Executive Pay Plan and Executive Longevity Schedule effective January 6, 2011. This Item also establishes the job classifications that are assigned to each of the salary grades in the Executive Pay Plan.

Effective January 6, 2011 the annual compensation for the salary grades in the Executive Pay Plan shall be as follows:

Salary Grade	Minimum Annual Salary	Maximum Annual Salary
EX01	\$124,836	\$218,618
EX02	\$106,478	\$184,245
EX03	\$ 95,463	\$145,684
EX04	\$ 74,657	\$114,259
EX05	\$ 40,000	\$106,478

Effective January 6, 2011 the longevity schedule associated with the Executive Pay Plan shall be as follows:

Effective January 6, 2011 longevity payments shall only be made to those individuals that were eligible and received such payments in October, 2010 and shall be based upon the years of service such Individual had on January 6, 2011.




