Daily Rentals


Fleet continues to rent vehicles on an hourly, daily or weekly basis. And it's not only compact cars that are available, there are sedans from both Ford and Chevrolet, minivans, 12-passenger vans, SUVs and even a box truck with lift-gate. In addition, two Chevrolet Volts will be coming soon. The Volts were made possible by a grant from the Connecticut Clean Fuel program. This

assistance will enable us to have a Volt available for daily rentals by early 2015 from both our Wethersfield and Buckingham locations.



Over the fiscal year that ended June 30th we had vehicles out for a total 2,822 rental days. This is just 3% off of our all time high achieved a year earlier.


Number of Vehicle Rental Days By Quarter




January 1 - March 31
