
Daily Rentals



Below are breakdown charts of our rental days by quarter for the past five years.


Number of Vehicle Rental Days By Quarter




January 1 - March 31



April 1 - June 30




July 1 - September 30

Tablets

Fleet Operations has begun testing the use of tablet computers in our shops. Their portability will enable us to better handle certain vehicle-related issues. Accidents and turn-in inspections are two areas which we will initially be using the tablets for help. Employees at Fleet garages will now be able to document vehicle condition, including photos, then share this with the necessary parties electronically, right from the tablet. No more filling out forms and faxing, then downloading pictures from a camera and emailing separately.

Being able to provide timely information and photos together in one email will help our insurance representatives better serve us because they will now have immediate access to everything they need to quickly and successfully expedite claims. Capturing all of the necessary data on one device will also assist us by organizing all necessary related information in a single consolidated folder for future reference.

Looking forward, as is the case with most technology advancements, we suspect there will be many other areas that tablets will improve operations at Fleet.

Need Gas?

DOT has reported changes with two of their stations. One is temporarily closing, while another has reopened.

- **New Milford** –Station # 510, located on Rt. 7 just north of Rt. 202 is currently closed for repairs. It is scheduled to reopen this fall.
- **Bolton**– Station 550/Bolton at 362 Boston Turnpike (Rt. 6) near the junction of Rt. 85 has reopened.
